

# BAYARD HIGH SCHOOL ALUMNI ASSOCIATION

## CONSTITUTION

### ARTICLE I. NAME

This Association shall be known as the Bayard High School Alumni Association.

### ARTICLE II. PURPOSE

This is a non-profit organization dedicated to the promotion of friendship, fellowship and the perpetuation of good memories and school spirit through annual reunions, newsletters and other appropriate promotions.

### ARTICLE III. MEMBERSHIP

Section 1. (Sentence Omitted) Membership is dependent upon the payment of a designated yearly fee required to finance annual mailings of reunion notices, lists of members with current addresses and other promotional activities of the Association.

Section 2. Associate membership is open to class parents and school staff who were employed or taught in the Bayard school system. Associate members are not required to pay the annual membership fee.

### ARTICLE IV. OFFICERS

Section 1. The Executive Committee of the Association shall consist of a president, vice-president, secretary and treasurer as elective officers; the immediate past-president will act in an advisory capacity.

Section 2. Elections in accordance with the bylaws shall be held at each annual meeting to ratify the selection of new officers. If possible, the incumbent vice-president will become the new president, and the incumbent president will become the advisor.

Section 3. The officers of secretary and treasurer shall be elected on alternate years, but not both offices in the same year unless approved by the membership at the annual meeting.

Section 4. Upon death, resignation , or removal of any officer, the Executive Committee shall fill the vacancy until the next election.

Section 5. An alumni coordinator may be named by the Executive Committee to serve for a designated time in an advisory capacity.

## **ARTICLE V. COMMITTEES**

Section 1. There shall be such standing committee(s) as may be deemed necessary by the membership.

Section 2. A standing committee(s) shall consist of not less than three members.

Section 3. The chairman and members of the standing committee(s) shall be appointed by the president.(phrase omitted)

Section 4. A nominating committee shall be appointed by the president for the purpose of selecting a vice-president and secretary or treasurer for the following year, such selection to be ratified by the membership at the next annual meeting.

Section 5. Special committees shall be appointed by the president as required.

## **ARTICLE VI. AMENDMENTS**

Section 1. This constitution may be amended by a majority vote at the annual meeting.

Section 2. Amendments to the constitution shall become effective immediately upon approval as provided in Section 1 of this Article.
