

APPROVED GUIDELINES FOR BHS ALUMNI ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP

1. Must furnish proof that they have enrolled in a school for advanced training or are in the process of enrolling.
2. Students must have participated in extra curricular activities.
3. Student should show other scholarships they have received.
4. Must show they process character.
5. A student attending a school in Nebraska will be given first choice. Scholarship will be good for any type of post secondary education.

SELECTION COMMITTEE

The selection committee shall consist of the following persons:

- School Counselor
- Two Alumni Officers
- Two Appointed Alumni

The two alumni will be appointed at the Annual Meeting. The Officers will decide among themselves on which officers will serve on the committee.

The committee shall select two students for the scholarships and one student as alternate. The alternate will use the scholarship if the first student elects not to attend school.

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP AND METHOD OF AWARDING

The first scholarship will be for \$1500 and the second for \$1500. Payments will be made in two equal installments. The first installment shall be at the start of the first semester and the second payment will be made at the start of the second semester. If the school or training program is not based on the semester plan, the payment of the scholarship we be adjusted accordingly. At graduation the student will be given a certificate and an award letter. The money shall be sent to the financial aid office of the school of the student's choice. This office will then issue one-half of the scholarship for the first semester and one-half at the start of the second semester. If the student does not enroll for the second semester the money will be given to the alternate.

SCHOLARSHIP CONTINUANCE

The Alumni Association will assess each Bayard Alumnus who is a member of the Association \$5 per year for the scholarship fund. These funds will remain separate from other Alumni funds.
